SEARCH AND SEIZURE

The Carson City School District is committed to providing an orderly academic environment for learning that promotes the acquisition of knowledge and advances the free exchange of ideas. The preservation of this educational environment is an important objective for the District. Incidents which jeopardize the health, safety and welfare of the school community may necessitate the search of students and their property, student use areas, student lockers, and automobiles. Such searches may necessitate the seizure of illegal unauthorized drugs, or controlled substances, alcohol, devices or contraband discovered during the search.

The Board directs the Superintendent to develop regulations setting forth the circumstances and procedures required to be followed in the search of students and their property, student use areas, student lockers, and student automobiles and any resulting seizure of any evidence found.
